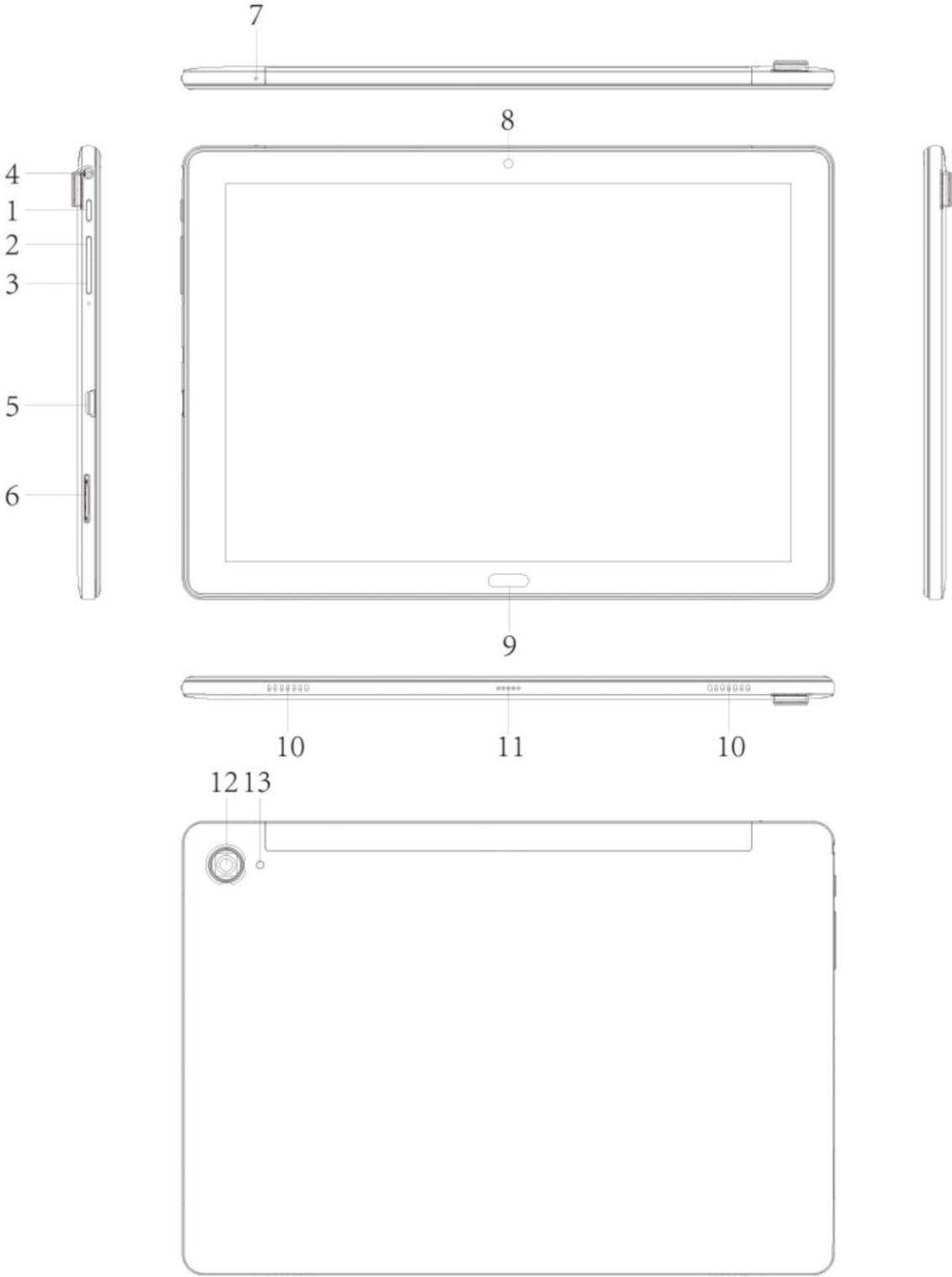

User Manual

Getting to know the ProMa King Tablet



At a Glance

1. Power Button: Press and hold the power button for 3 seconds to start up; Press it down to start or close the touch panel; Long press for 8 seconds to reset.
2. Volume + : Volume Up
3. Volume – : Volume Down
4. 3.5mm Earphone Port
5. Type–C Port
6. Nano SIM / TF (choose two of three)
7. Built–in MIC Port
8. Front Camera
9. Home Key
10. Built–in Speaker Output Hole
11. Docking Port
12. Rear Camera
13. Flashlight

Preparations

Connecting to PC

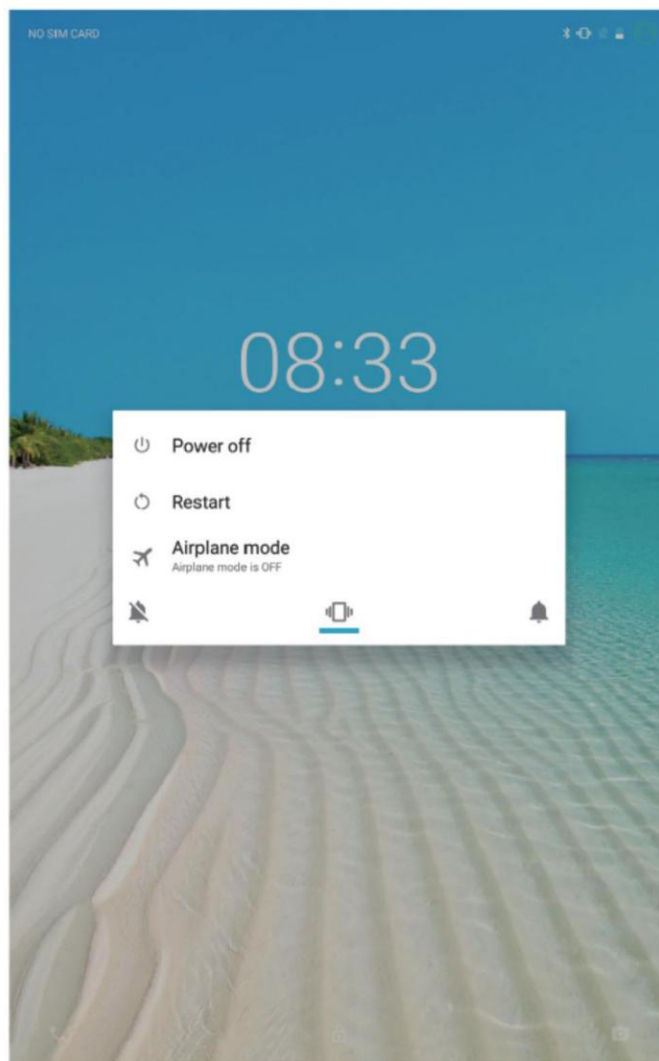
Boot the PC, and connect the device to the PC via the special USB cable, then you can transmit data between the PC and your tablet. Mount as USB mass storage, then you can copy or delete files on your device with your PC.

Notice: While the device is mounted as mass storage, you cannot play the media files in it. ProMa will not be held responsible for damages resulting from this kind of improper operation.

Booting

In shutdown state, long press the power button for 3 seconds and the system will go into the Android progress bar.

Approximately 40 seconds later the system will go into the lock screen. To unlock the screen, slide upward from the bottom of the screen.



Battery Saving Mode & Screen Lock: When the tablet goes into battery saving mode, the display will black out and the OS will go to the lockscreen. Press the power button again and the screen will be awakened in one second.

Notice: Battery saving mode will only put off the display, running applications such as music player will continue to work.


Notice: If the tablet crashes you should hold down the power button for eight seconds to force a reboot.

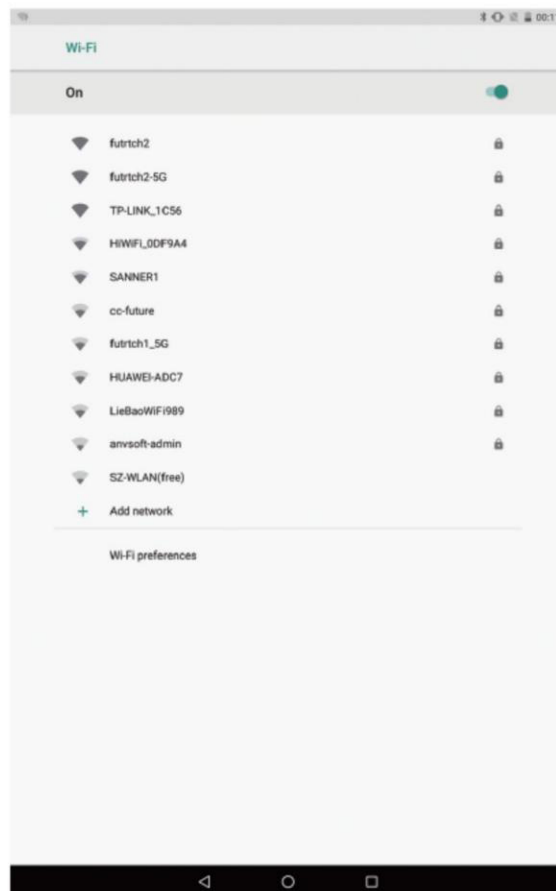
Shutting down

While the tablet is on, long press the power button for 3 seconds, a shutdown confirmation window will pop up. Choose to “shutdown” and the tablet will be turned off.

Notice: If the battery is too low, the tablet will fire up alarms from time to time. If you don't charge it immediately, it will automatically be turned off while the battery is used up. If you cannot boot the tablet after you connect it to the charging cable, please wait for 5-10 minutes before you try again.

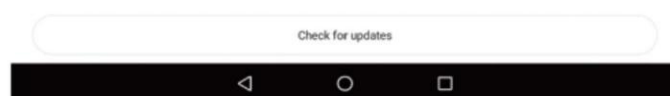
Wi-Fi Settings

1. Turning on: Open the app drawer and find the Setting icon  , touch to open the setting menu, slide the Wi-Fi switcher to turn on Wi-Fi.
2. Choose the available wifi access , for example, the “**ProMa_4**”, then it will require you to put in the password, click “connect” . Once you put in the correct password, the system will help you obtain the IP address. Once it is successfully connected, you will see a connected icon in the status bar.



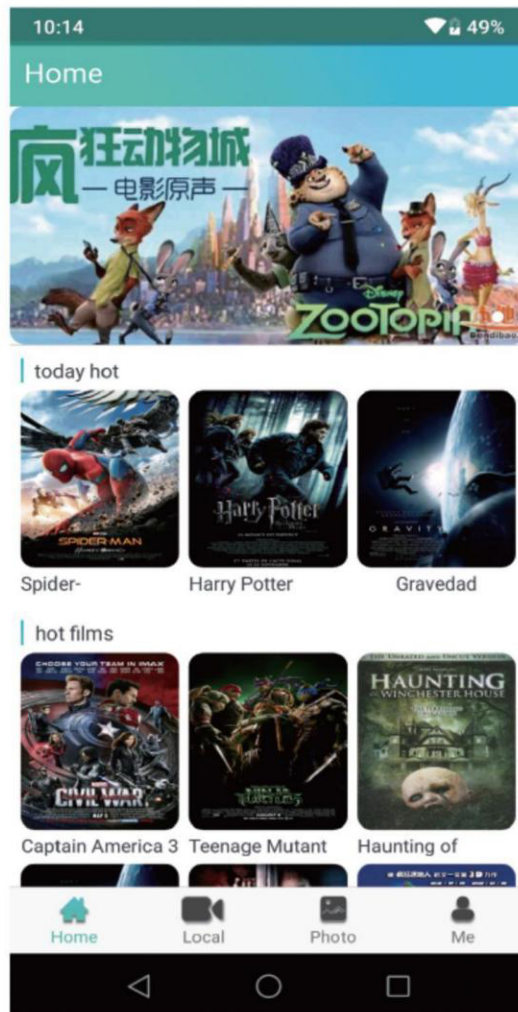
OTA Update

ProMa will push notifications to your tablet if any updated firmwares are available. You can use OTA to update your device. Also you can check the available updated firmware by: Setting - About the tablet - online update.

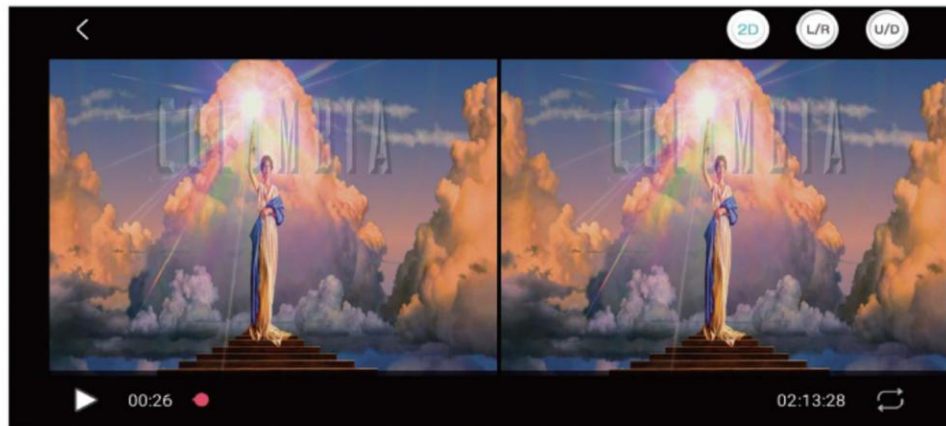


Sight 3D

Tap the “Sight 3D” icon on the home screen, then you can see the main page of the app below:

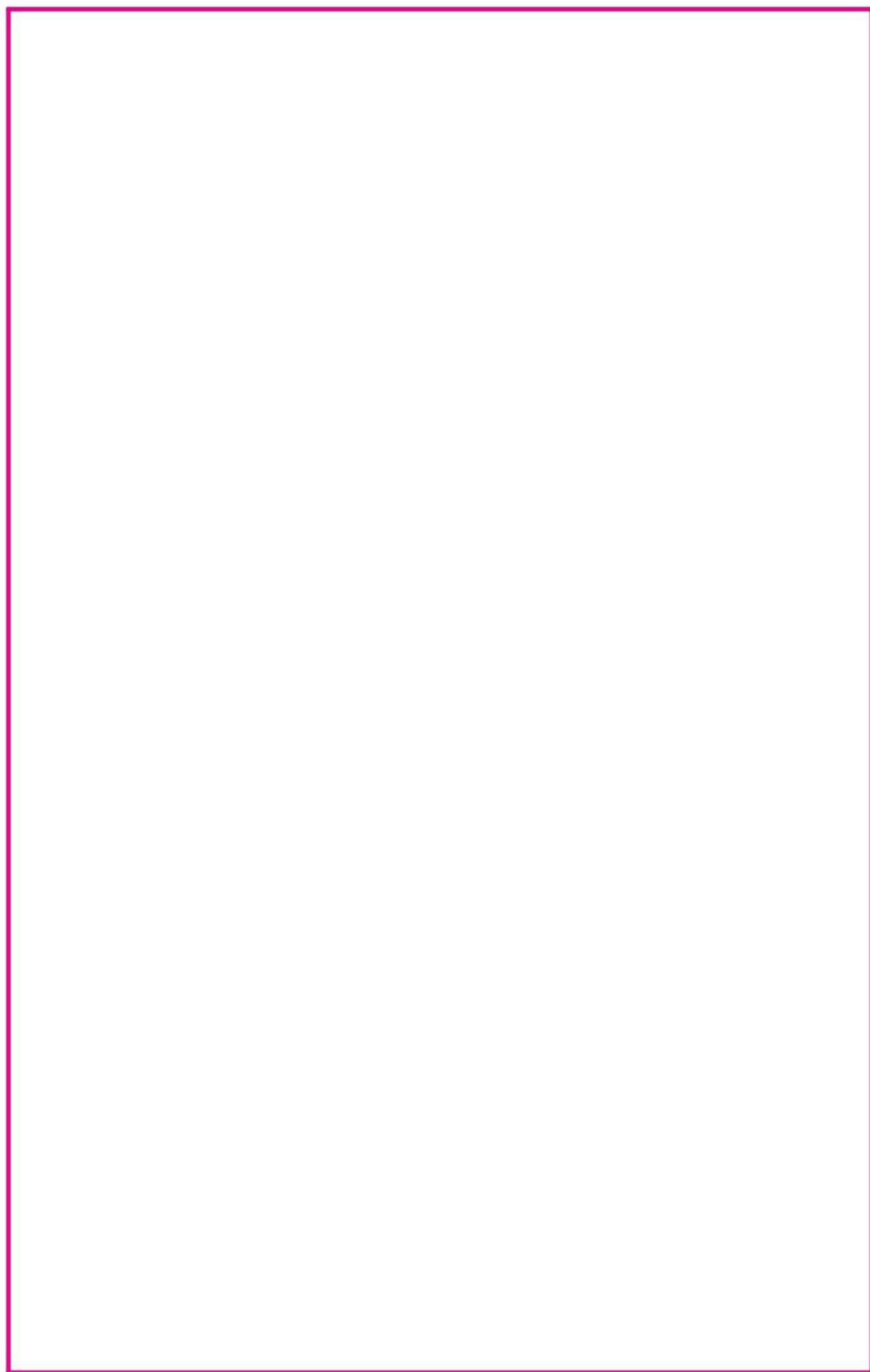
